

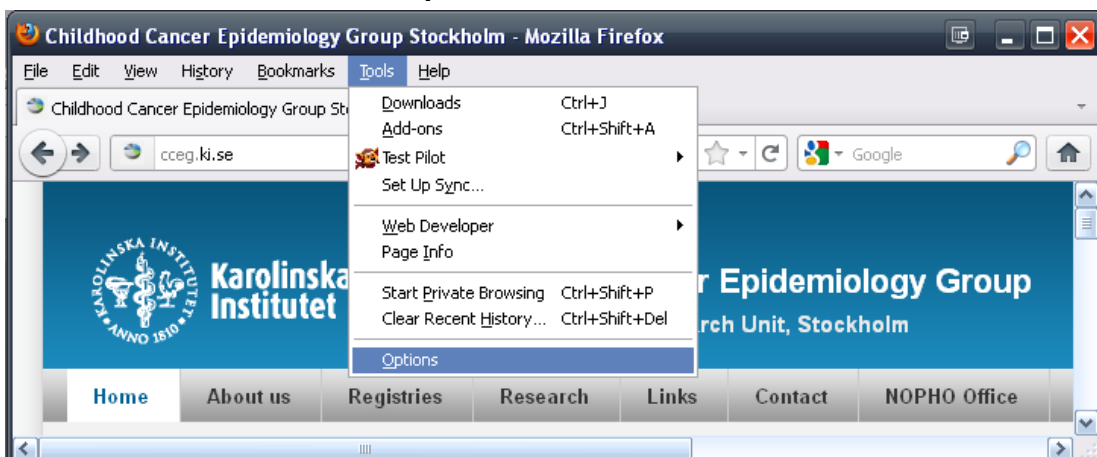
# Certificate Installation in Firefox

This installation is done in Firefox 7 on Windows XP. If this guide does not answer your questions please do not hesitate to contact CCEG.

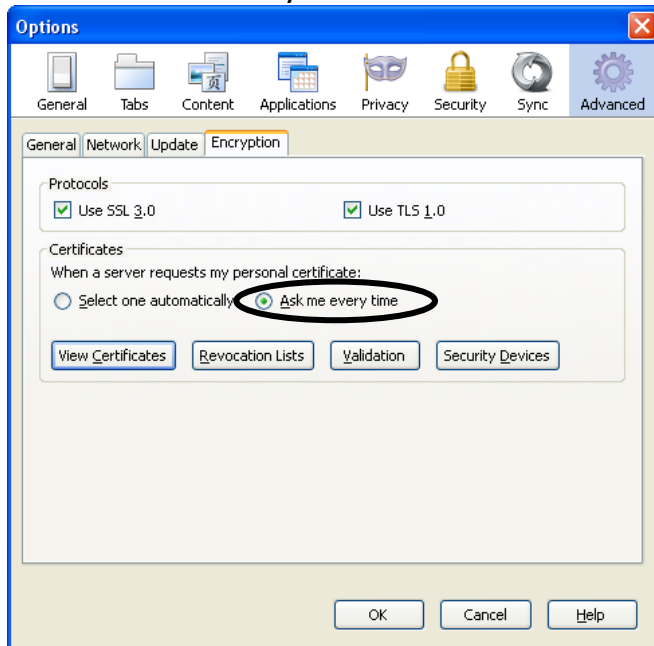
1. Download the certificate on to your computer. It can be downloaded from the CCEG website at [www.cceg.ki.se](http://www.cceg.ki.se). Choose **“Download certificate”** in the dropdown menu on the right. See below.



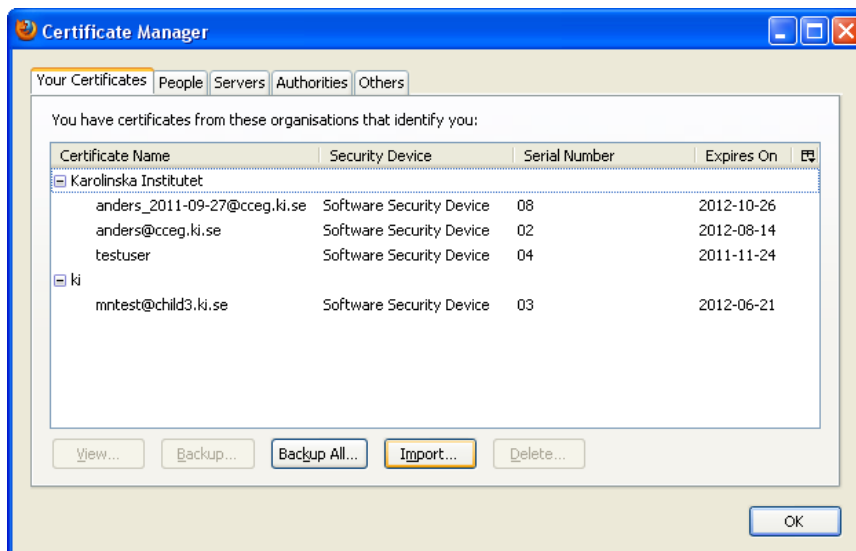
2. Start Firefox and choose **“Options”** in the **“Tools”** menu.



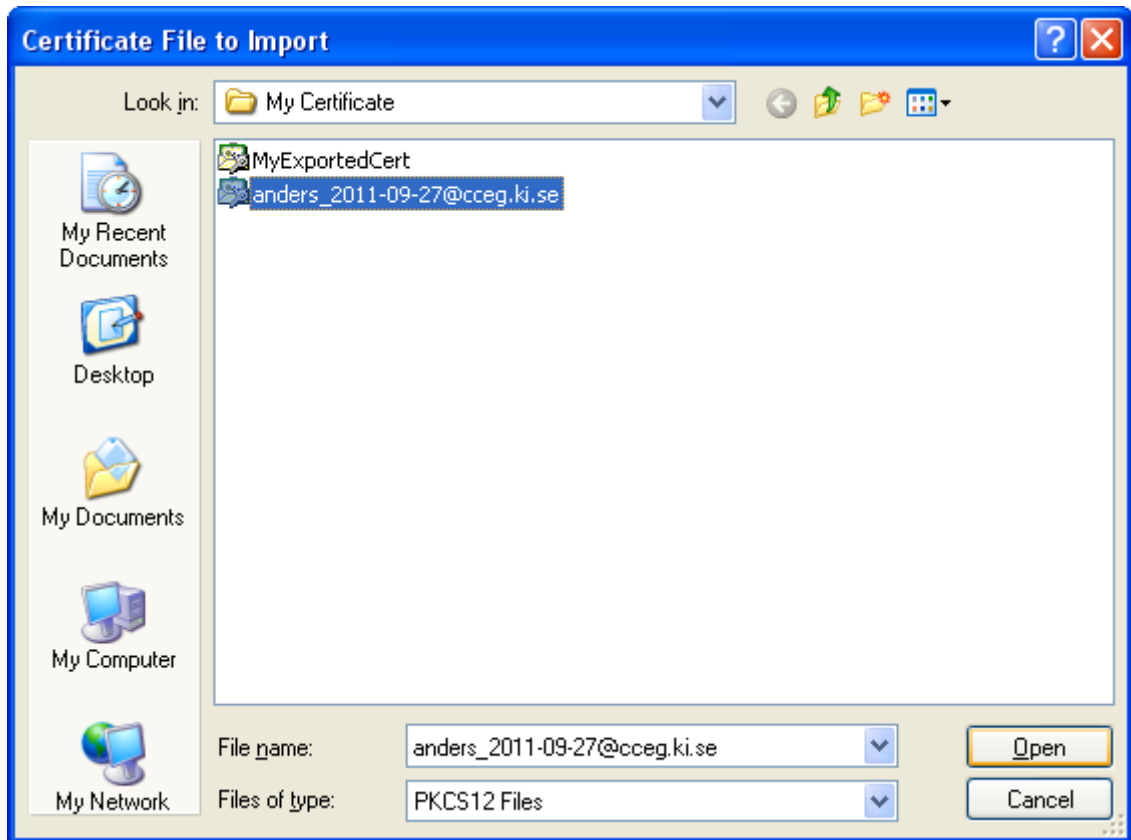
3. Navigate to the **“Advanced”** pane. On the **“Encryption”** tab below **“Certificates”**, **“When a server requests my personal certificate”** make sure **“Ask me every time”** is selected. Click **“View Certificates”**.



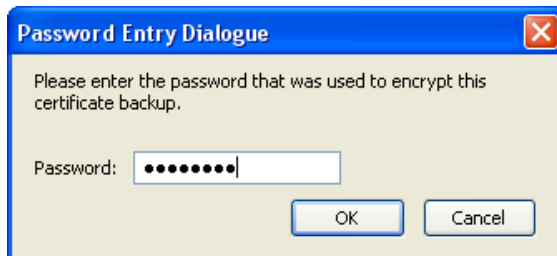
4. Click **“Import...”** under **“Your Certificates”** tab.



5. Select your certificate and click **“Open”**

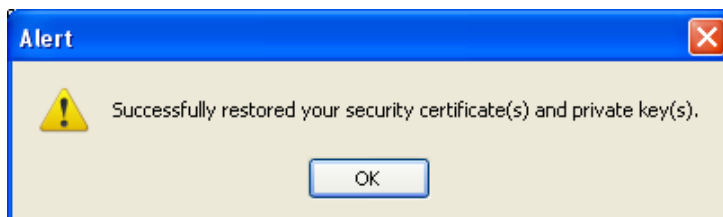


6. Enter the installation password and click **“OK”**.

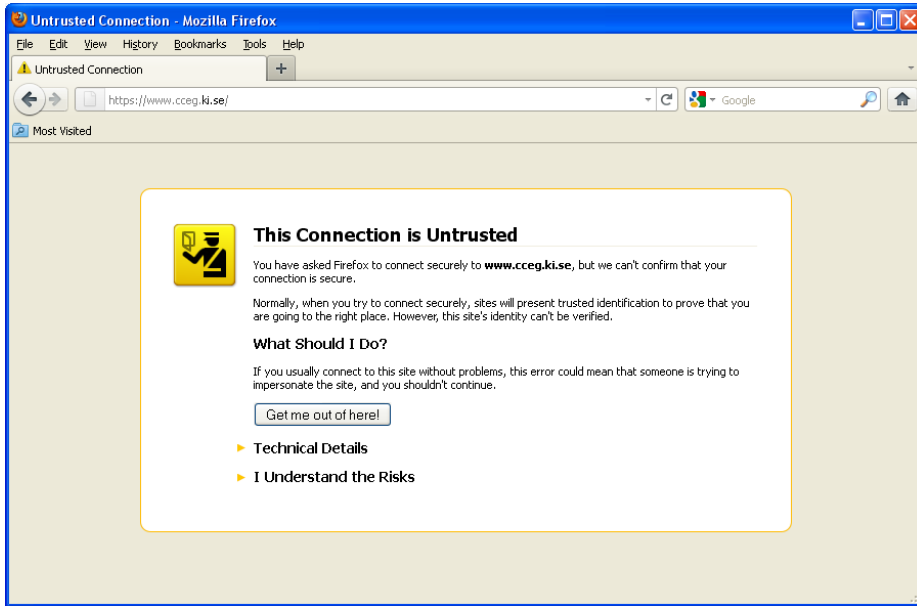


Users who gained access prior to September 2011 have had a password sent to them by fax. New users have had the password sent to them by email.

7. The certificate is installed. Click **“OK”**



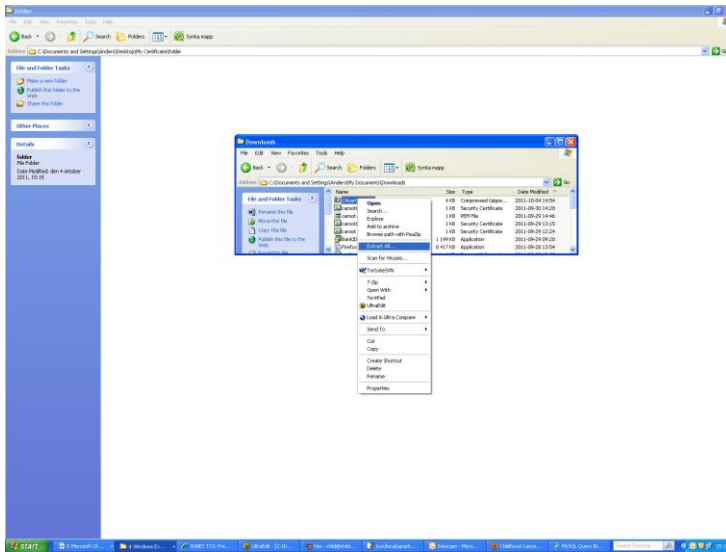
8. If you try to connect to the registry and the browser shows an error page(as shown below) download and install CA certificates.



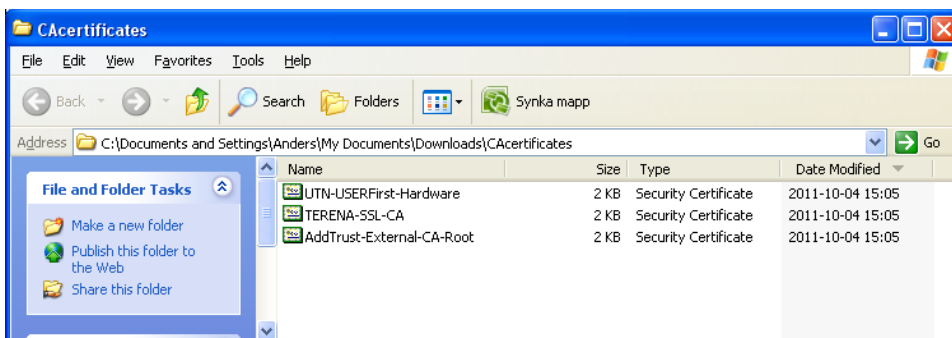
9. Go to [www.cceg.ki.se](http://www.cceg.ki.se) and click "Access" the CA certificates is on the right. Save the compressed file on your computer.



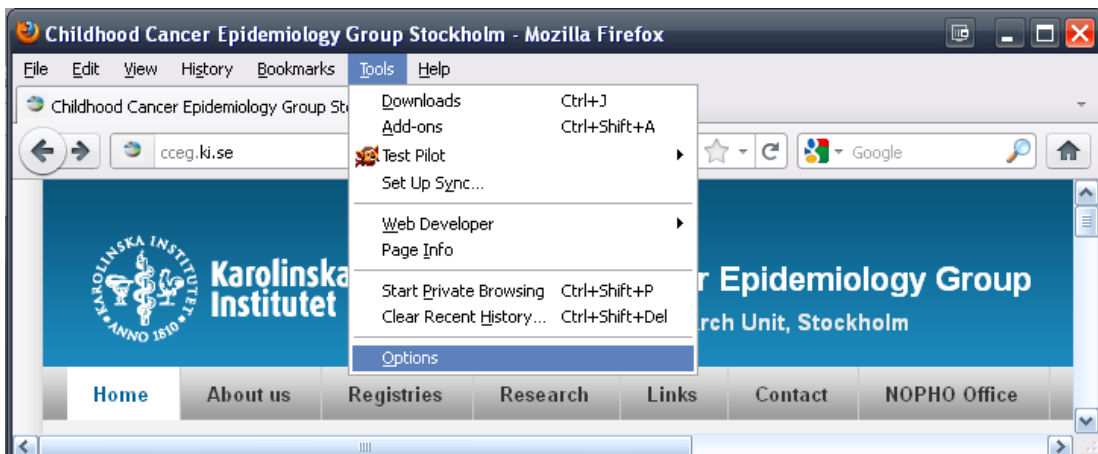
10. Uncompress the CA certificates by choosing “Extract All” with a right click on the downloaded file.



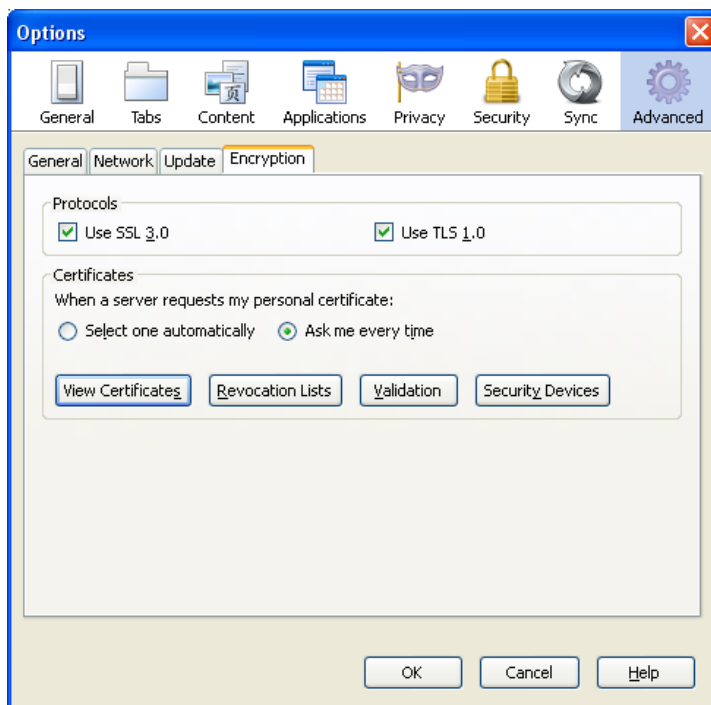
10. The CA certificate files.



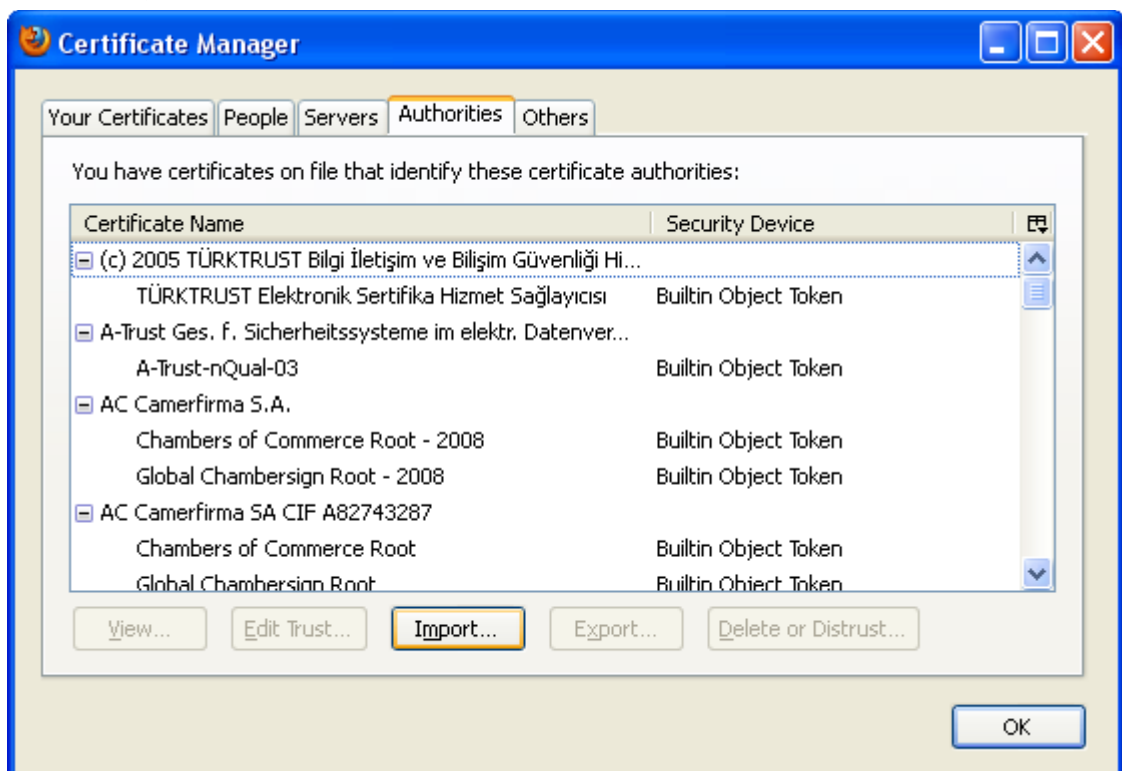
11. Import the CA certificates one by one. Choose “Options” in the “Tools” menu.



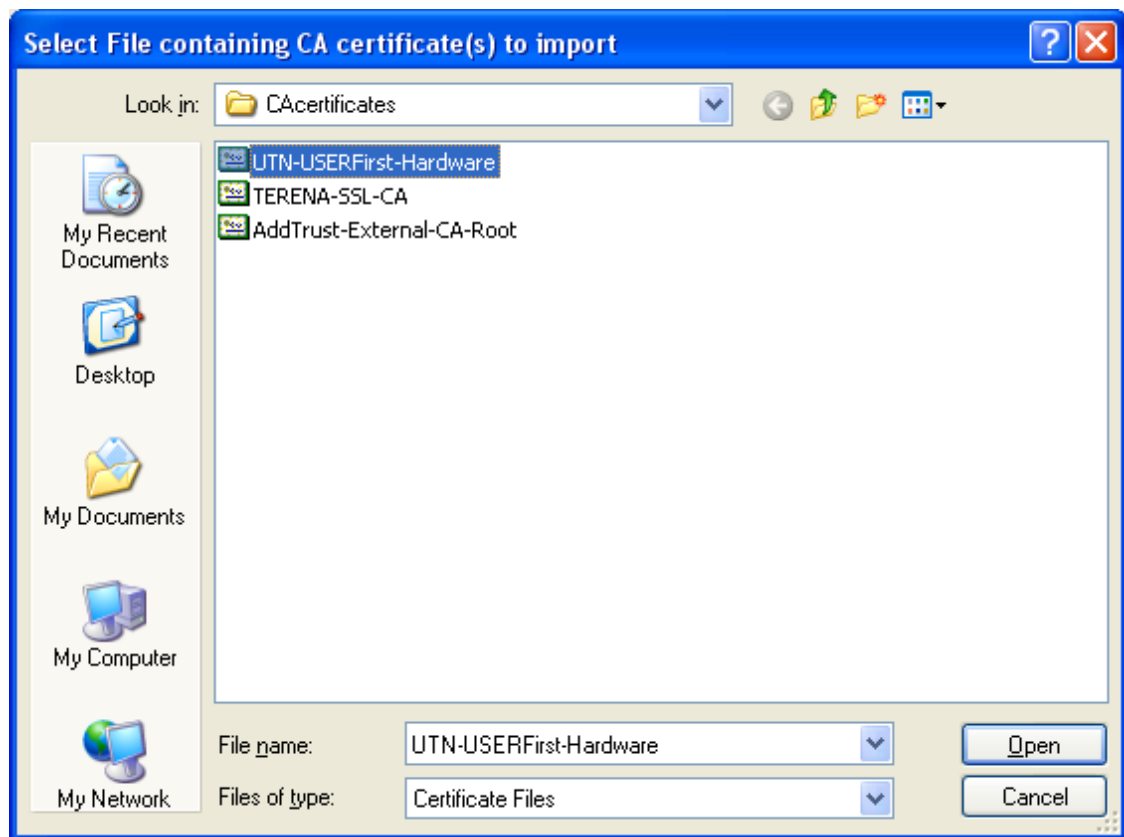
12. Navigate to the “Advanced” pane and click “View Certificates”.



13. Click “Import...” under “Authorities” tab.



14. Select a CA certificate.



15. Tick all checkboxes and click "OK".
